Select Men for S. Town, have bargained sold & delivered, &
by these presents do bargain sell & deliver unto said
Select Men & to their Successors in said Office one
Certain Negro Girl named Dinah —

To have & to hold said Negro Girl Dinah to them
the said Select Men & to their Successors in said Office for the
full end & term of four years fully to be completed &
ended; after which time said Girl shall become free, and
thereby be entitled to all the Privileges granted by our
Laws to Emancipated Slaves — Further I the said Cadwell
do hereby relinquish all right & title in & to S. Girl; and
hereby do & will warrant & defend S. Girl to said Select
Men & to their Successors in Office, as being free from
all Claims and Demands whatsoever — In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this
14th day of August 1792 —
