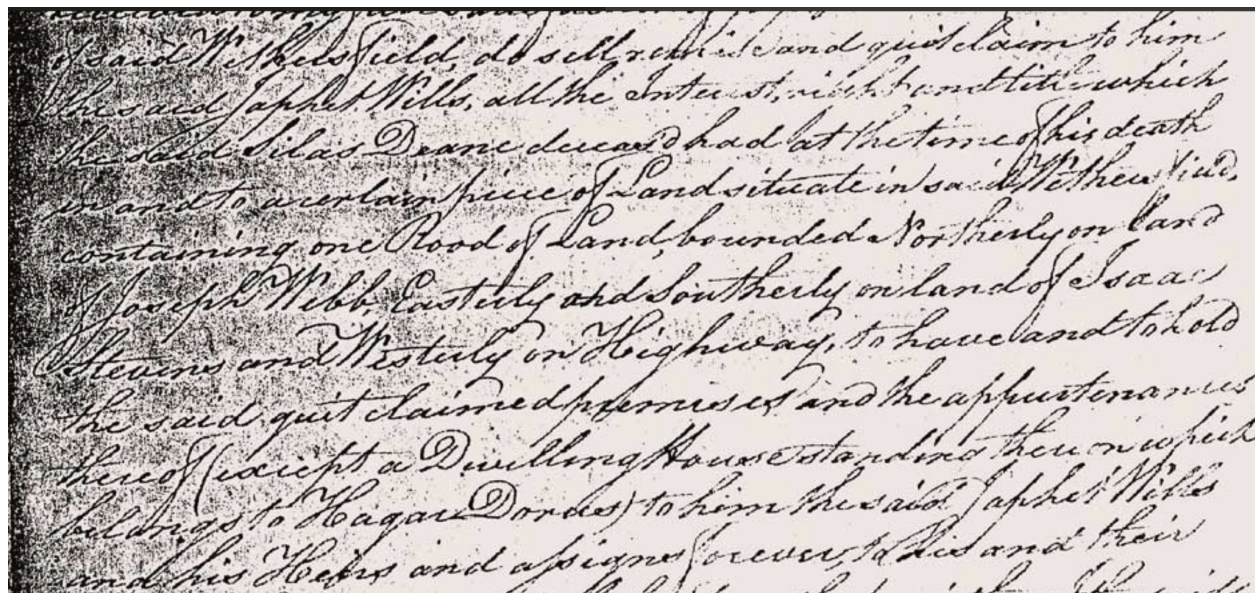


Japhet Will Purchase of Pomp Dorus land (Silasdeaneonline.org)

To all People to whom these presents shall come Greeting Know ye that I Jesse Deane of Hartford in the County of Hartford & State of Connecticut Administrator on the Estate of Silas Deane Esquire late of Wethersfield in said County deceased in pursuance of an order of the Court of Probate for the District of Hartford in said State, and for consideration of thirty Dollars received to my satisfaction of Japhet Wills (a Blackman) of said Wethersfield, do sell, release and quit claim to him the said Japhet Wills, all the Interest, right and title which the said Silas Deane deceas'd had at the time of his death in and to a certain piece of Land situated in said Wethersfield, containing one Rood of Land, bounded Northerly on land of Joseph Webb, Easterly and Southerly on land of Isaac Stevens and Westerly on Highway, to have and to hold the said quit claimed premises and the appurtenances thereof (except a Dwelling House standing thereon which belongs to Hagar Dorus) to him the said Japhet Wills and his Heirs and assigns forever, to his and their proper use and beh[???]of; so that neither the said Jesse Deane, nor any other person in my name or behalf, shall or will claim any right or title to the premises or any part thereof (except as above excepted) but from such claim shall be forever barred & excluded.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 22nd day of April AD1814.
