The residue of my Estate both real and personal after the death of my wife I give and bequeath to my Nephews William James John and Walter Sons of my brother James Smith and to their heirs forever to be equally divided between the said William James John and Walter. And I do hereby appoint my brother James Smith Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my my hand and Seal this 15th day of March in the Year of Our Lord 1817

In the Name of God Amen I Elisha Pitkin of East Hartford ^{in the County of Hartford} and State of Connecticut of lawful age and sound mind and Memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following. In the first place I give my Soul unto God who gave it trusting in the Mercy of God through the Merits of Christ for salvation My body to a decent Christian Burial at the direction of my Executors.

My worldly Estate with God has been pleased to bless me sends what I have given to my Children and Grand Children by Deeds of Gift or otherwise My Will is that it be disposed of in manner following after my just debts and Funeral Charges are paid.

First I give One hundred dollars to the Bible Society One half to the permanent fund and the other to be applied according to the direction of the Society. Also I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Pitkin Eighty dollars to be paid in Movable or Annuity price.

Also I give unto my grandson Elisha Pitkin One hundred Acres of Land in Sheffield in the State of New Vermont near Tara lake so called on the North line of said Sheffield laid out to me on the Original right of Henry Pitkin third division.

Also I give unto my granddaughter Elizabeth Pitkin nee Elizabeth Allen the Eastern half of One hundred Acre lot joining North in part on the aforesaid lot given to Elisha Pitkin laid out to me on the two half rights of Obadiah Horsford and Alexander Phelps third division. Also One half of two half rights laid out to Obadiah Horsford and Alexander Phelps first division or there lot being Twenty five Acres.

Also I give to the heirs of my grandson Newton Pitkin deceased One dollar One dollar. Also I give to my grandson Henry Pitkin if he be living and shall return here to receive it Two hundred dollars to be paid him by my Sons Samuel Pitkin the heirs of Timothy Pitkin deceased Edward Pitkin and Joseph Pitkin in equal parts out of what I shall give them as the residuary part of my Estate. Also I give unto my Son Edward Pitkin all and singular my Farming Utensils. Also the Bed helter two pillows undressed Bedstead and Cord Reddish brown Bedquilt and three blankets which are in the North front Room.

Also I give unto my Sons Samuel the heirs of Timothy deceased Edward Joseph and my daughter Elizabeth Pitkin and their heirs my land I bought
